**The Ohio Chapter suffered a cardiac arrest, and after bystanders started BLS, a Rapid Response team arrived to perform ACLS.**

I would like to recognize the bystanders: Dominika Skarka and Elizabeth Farrington from SCCM, and the Rapid Respond team: the Chapter Executive Board. The community outreach event was a way to accomplish the Mission of the Chapter: to offer educational and networking opportunities for critical care providers with 32 ICU providers attending dinner and numerous ICU providers attending the webinar offered by Dr. Bailey.

**The Ohio Chapter has a pulse!**

I want to recognize the amazing work accomplished by every committee. The Education Committee led by Eduardo Mireles and Michael Rudoni from CCF has organized quarterly webinars with 40-50 viewers on average, offering now CME credits; the logo contest that gave us our beautiful new logo; and the FDM course led by Mada Helou with 15 attendees. The Communication Committee led by Paige Barger from the University of Cincinnati who designed our new website with incredible expertise and creativity, with an average of more than 6 visits per day, and established the Ohio Chapter in Social Media with increasing number of followers in Instagram (39); Facebook (60) and Twitter (131). The hard work by the Membership Committee led by Floria Chae from OSU has increased the membership by over 30%, from 215 to 286 members in one year, and we are now focusing on attracting Pediatric Critical Care members. ## OHIO CHAPTER COMMUNITY OUTREACH

*American Heart Association Heart Walk  
September 20, 2019*

We were honored and thrilled to have Dr. Heatherlee Bailey, President of SCCM, join the Ohio Chapter for two days in Cleveland as part of the American Heart Association's (AHA) Heart Walk. Dr. Bailey was the guest speaker for the Chapter's quarterly webinar on September 20<sup>th</sup>, providing an engaging review of *Updates in CPR and Post Cardiac Arrest Care*—a reminder of how we arrived at the current standard of cardiac arrest management and how care continues to evolve. Most importantly, she emphasized that all of us—healthcare professionals and civilians—are capable of saving a life. Later that evening, Chapter members enjoyed a wonderful meal and had an opportunity to socialize while being treated to Dr. Bailey recounting her inspirational leadership journey. The weekend culminated with the AHA Heart Walk in downtown Cleveland. There, the Ohio Chapter hosted a booth in collaboration with PulsePoint, a free mobile app aimed at improving communication between local public safety agencies and citizens and empowering CPR-trained bystanders to help reduce the millions of annual deaths from Sudden Cardiac Arrest. Together with Dr. Bailey, Ohio Chapter members volunteered to spread the word about PulsePoint and even gave spectators the chance to demonstrate their chest compression-skills on a CPR mannequin! Those who participated in the walk were celebrated at the finish line, with a special reception for survivors of a cardiac event.
