Heparin Induced Thrombocytopenia (HIT) **Presented by: Majdi Hamarshi, MD, FCCP, FCCM**



Dr. Majdi Hamarshi completed medical school at Al-Quds University in East Jerusalem/Palestine, an internal medicine residency at Advocate Christ Medical Center in Chicago, IL, and a fellowship in pediatric critical care at The University of Missouri at Kansas City School of Medicine (UKMC). He is currently an associate clinical professor and the program director of the critical care fellowship program at UKMC. He has over a dozen published works including assessments of diagnostic scoring tools for the diagnosis of heparin-induced thrombocytopenia.
