Dr. Kummer completed his medical education at Washington University School of Medicine in St Louis, MO and received his PhD from there as well. He attended Harvard Medical School in Boston, MA for his Neurology training and completed a fellowship at Harvard in Neurocritical Care. He also holds a Master of Science of Clinical Investigation.

Dr. Kummer is an Associate Professor of Critical Care Neurology at Washington University, where he is the Director of the Neurotrauma ICU, the Associate Director of Critical Care Neurology, the site lead for the Acute Effects of Neurotrauma Consortium, and the Director of the EXPLORE program. Dr. Kummer also works as a Neurologist in the VA St. Louis Healthcare system.
